In 2010, **National Handcuff Day** was established to commemorate February 20, 1912, when a patent was issued to for the invention of a "lightweight and adjustable swinging bow ratchet-type handcuff". George Carney invented the design which was deemed <u>more comfortable</u> than previous styles.

Maybe this is the reason why we don't celebrate National Handcuff Day on June 17 when the first patent for adjustable handcuffs was issued to William Adams in 1862. Adams, a successful businessman in New York, did not have a background in policing or lock making, as did other handcuff inventors. He owned a company which manufactured lamps.
